

Restaurant Commission Vs Server Commission Explanation

The end of day reports show the total server commission and the total Restaurant commission.

Server Commission: This is the amount subtracted from the server tip based on the commission percentage setup for the receipt type. For example, a charge is made to a receipt type called master card with a tip of \$1.00. The server commission for this receipt type is set for 10%, therefore, the server commission is \$0.10.

Restaurant Commission: This is the amount the restaurant is charged for the credit card transaction based on the commission percentage defined in the receipt setup. For example, if a check is paid to the master card receipt type and the total sale is \$10.00, the restaurant commission would be %10 of the total sales. In this case the Restaurant commission would be \$1.00
